LCD Report – No report

District Reports

Center Valley District - “S” and “A” Project – Dale Richley has hired an attorney and we have contacted our attorney. The Board has reviewed future steps with the attorney. Mr. Richley will not speak to Board members as directed by his attorney. Chapter 30 permit will be applied for the dredging that needs to be completed on that portion of the legal drain. Any future on-site visits should be done by 2 Board members and if issues arise the Sheriff’s Department needs to be contacted.

Center/Grand Chute District - Casaloma Drive – Tree cutting is being done. Speedy Clean needs to be contacted to clean out tile at Edgewood and McCarthy.

Duck Creek District –

Duck Creek Annexation – Borings are being completed by Omni. About 1 ½ feet of sediment, original bottom of muck and about down 6 feet hitting clay. The ditches average about 1 ½ feet of sediment from the south to about half way.

The area of 47 and Twelve Corners Road should be checked to see that the seeding is greening

Vandenbroek District – Van Asten reported at Highway 55 and County Road UU the water is running through very well, where it had flooded in the past is clear of water now. Where the culverts cross, rip rap should be placed, under UU. Highway Department will be contacted.

Senate Bill 263 – nothing new. An email was sent by Kramer to Steineke to change the fiscal year ending December 31.
