OUTAGAMIE COUNTY NUTRITION PROGRAM

The Outagamie County Nutrition Program is coordinated by the Outagamie County Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC) and under the direction of the Outagamie County Department of Health and Human Services.

Monday through Friday mid-day meals are delivered to Outagamie County eligible residents 60 years and older who are frail, homebound by reason of illness, disability or isolation and for whom an assessment concludes that Home Delivered meal service participation is in the individual's best interest.

All participants are assessed by Outagamie County Nutrition Program staff to determine Home Delivered meal service eligibility.

In accordance with the state and federal Older Americans Act, the Outagamie County Nutrition Program may not charge for meal service. Nutrition Program participants may donate voluntarily toward the meal cost. No participant will be denied meal service because they cannot or will not donate toward the meal cost. A suggested meal donation is established. Donations are confidential and support Outagamie County Nutrition Program meal service continuation.

KAUKAUNA MEALS ON WHEELS

(WITHIN KAUKAUNA AND SURROUNDING SERVICE AREA)

Kaukauna Meals on Wheels is a non-profit, community-based Home Delivered meal service.

Volunteers deliver Monday through Friday mid-day meals to eligible homebound residents of **Kaukauna, Little Chute, Kimberly, Combined Locks and surrounding communities**. St. Paul Elder Services prepares and packages Kaukauna Meals on Wheels Home Delivered meals.

The \$6.00 meal cost includes hot meal, sandwich and soup for the evening.

NEW LONDON HOME DELIVERED MEALS

(WITHIN OUTAGAMIE COUNTY SERVICE AREA)

Waupaca County Department of Health and Human Services contracts with the Outagamie County Nutrition Program to provide Monday through Friday mid-day Home Delivered meals to eligible Outagamie County residents 60 years and older who are frail, homebound by reason of illness, disability or isolation and for whom an assessment concludes that Home Delivered meal service participation is in the individual's best interest.

Participants are assessed by Outagamie County Nutrition Program staff to determine meal service eligibility.

In accordance with the federal Older Americans Act, the Outagamie County Nutrition Program may not charge for meal service. Nutrition Program participants may donate voluntarily toward meal costs. No participant will be denied meal service because they cannot or will not donate toward the meal cost. A suggested meal donation is established. Donations are confidential and support Outagamie County Nutrition Program meal service continuation.

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RICO'S OUTREACH MEALS ON WHEELS
(WITHIN FREEDOM SERVICE AREA)

Rico's Outreach Meals on Wheels is a community-based Home Delivered meal service through Rico's Family Restaurant in Freedom.

Volunteers deliver Monday through Friday mid-day meals to homebound residents in the Freedom area who live **north of County Trunk JJ, south of County Trunk J and east of Highway 47**. Rico's Family Restaurant prepares and packages Rico's Outreach Meals on Wheels.

The \$5.00 meal cost includes hot meal or soup and sandwich with dessert.
