

MINUTES - PUBLIC HEARING

The Public Hearing was called to order by Chairperson Anthony at 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of hearing comments on the Final Plan for Redistricting Outagamie County (Map 36 A).

Supervisor Trentlage moved, seconded by Supervisor Nagler, to bring the public hearing to order. MOTION CARRIED BY VOICE VOTE.

Chairperson Anthony asked three times if anyone wished to speak.


Supervisor N. Hofacker, Town of Center, requested members consider amending the line in the Town of Freedom to draw the line straight up County Trunk C. Supervisor Hofacker acknowledged that a population deviation would occur, but he reported he felt that the change would not be that significant.

Supervisor C. Kramer, Town of Freedom, requested members consider approving a redistricting plan to reduce the number of supervisors to 31 from the final plan being considered of 36 supervisors. Supervisor Kramer reported that he felt 31 supervisors were sufficient and that 36 were too many.

County Planner Hendrick reported the public hearing was properly noticed and published in the paper on October 10, 17, and 24, 2011, and no written comments were received in the office.

Supervisor McDaniel moved, seconded by Supervisor Austin, to close the public hearing at 5:05 p.m. MOTION CARRIED BY VOICE VOTE.
