TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 In 1999, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) partnered with the American
2 Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) to create the
3 “National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week” campaign. This campaign is held
4 annually in April prior to the construction season in much of the nation. Through their
5 enforcement activities and other participation, the Outagamie County Sheriff’s
6 Department and Wisconsin State Patrol helped make “Work Zone Safety Awareness
7 Week” a success in previous years. The Sheriff’s Department has committed once again
8 in 2013 to conduct enforcement activities and work jointly with the Highway Department
9 to make “Work Zone Safety Awareness Week” a success. The Federal Highway
10 Administration has designated April 15 through April 19, 2013 as “National Work Zone
11 Safety Awareness Week”.

13 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Highway & Solid Waste Committee
14 recommend adoption of the following resolution.

15 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors designates April 15
16 through April 19, 2013 as “Work Zone Safety Awareness Week” in Outagamie County, and

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy
18 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Highway Commissioner, the Outagamie County Sheriff and
19 the Outagamie County Executive.
