

# ORDINANCE NO.: D—2014-15

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

*MAJORITY*

1 Currently, there are multiple posted speed limits on CTH "N" from CTH "OO" to 0.10 miles  
2 north of CTH "JJ". A speed study was recently completed which supports modifying the speed  
3 limits. This ordinance modifies the speed limits as described below and on the attached map.  
4 The Village of Little Chute is also supportive of these changes.  
5

6 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Highway, Recycling and Solid Waste  
7 Committee recommend adoption of the following ordinance.

8 BE IT ORDAINED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does amend Section 36-91  
9 "Speed Zones Established" of the Outagamie County Code of Ordinances to read as follows (deletions  
10 are struck through, additions are in bold, italics and underlined):

11 Sec. 36-91. – Speed zones established.

12 The speed limit on the following streets or portions of streets shall be as indicated:

13 (1) Twenty-five miles per hour.

14 CTH "N." Northerly from its intersection with CTH "OO" in the Village of  
15 Little Chute to the north corporate limits of the Village of Little Chute to  
16 Florida Ave. *Elm Drive.*

17  
18 (2) Thirty-five miles per hour.

19 *CTH "N" Northerly from Elm Drive to 0.15 miles north of Evergreen Drive.*

20 (3) Forty miles per hour.

21 CTH "N" From 0.3 of a mile north of CTH "OO" for a distance of 0.85 of a mile  
22 northerly to a point 0.1 of a mile north of Evergreen Dr. within the Village of Little  
23 Chute and the Town of Vandebroek.

24 CTH "N" on that portion of the roadway in the Township of Vandebroek from Jay  
25 St. northerly to 0.1 of a mile north of Evergreen Dr.

27 (4) Forty-five miles per hour

28 CTH "N" from 0.10 *0.15* miles north of Evergreen Drive to 0.10 miles north of  
29 CTH "JJ.", and  
30

1 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in effect upon approval by the  
2 Outagamie County Board of Supervisors, publication per §59.14 and §66.0103, upon erection of  
3 standard signs, and signing as required by Wisconsin State Statutes, and

4 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy  
5 of this ordinance to the Outagamie County Highway Commissioner and Municipal Code Corporation.

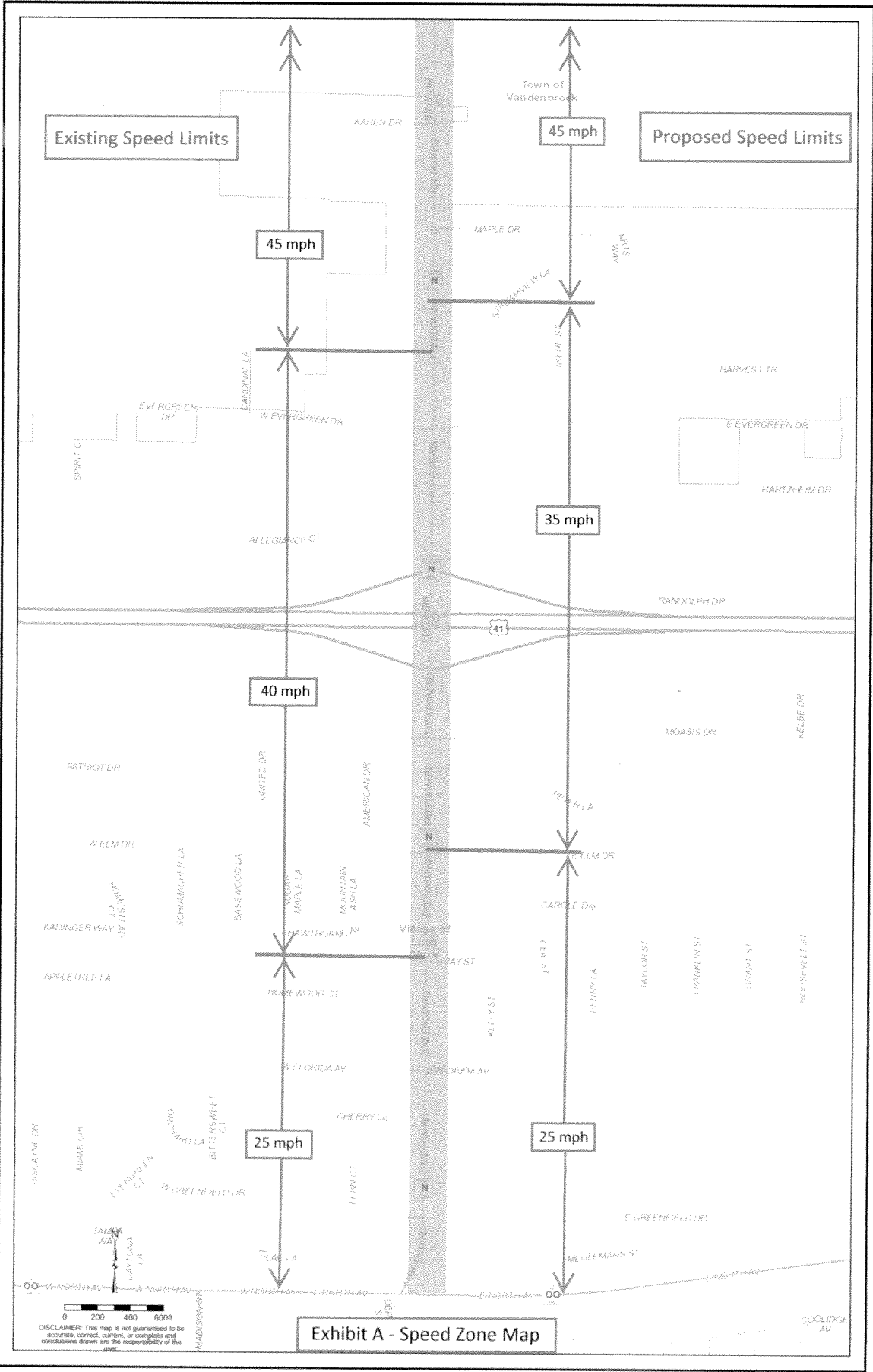

**RESOLUTION NO. 25, SERIES OF 2014**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING OUTAGAMIE COUNTY CHANGE SPEED LIMITS OF CERTAIN SECTIONS OF COUNTY HIGHWAY "N" FREEDOM ROAD WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LITTLE CHUTE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has forwarded to the Little Chute Plan Commission for review and recommendation of speed limits along Highway N; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Chute Plan Commission is aware of planned restriping of Freedom Road from Elm Drive South to Highway OO; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Chute Plan Commission is aware of the controlled and uncontrolled intersections and pedestrian crossings along the route; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Chute Plan Commission is aware of planned and commenced new development along and intersecting with the route; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Chute Plan Commission recommends reductions in speed limits along certain sections of Highway N; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Little Chute Board of Trustees believes that a much safer route will be established with posting new speed limits in conjunction with the planned restriping of lanes on Highway N.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, that the County is hereby requested to lower speed limits on Highway N within the Village as follows:


- 1) From Karen Drive, South to Elm Drive, reduced speed from 45 MPH to 35 MPH.
- 2) From Elm Drive South to Jay Street reduced from 40 MPH to 25 MPH and continuing past the Little Chute School to the intersection at Highway OO.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, copies of this resolution are to be forwarded to each County Supervisor serving residents of Little Chute as well as the County Executive.
