

RESOLUTION NO.: 175—2017-18

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 In 1999, the Federal Highway Administration partnered with the American Association
2 of State Highway Officials and more recently the American Traffic Safety Services
3 Association, to create the National Work Zone Safety Awareness campaign which is held
4 annually in April prior to construction season in much of the nation.
5

6 In each of the last three years, there have been over 2,000 work zone crashes in
7 Wisconsin. In 2017, there were nearly 2,700 crashes in road construction and
8 maintenance zones, resulting in over 1,000 injuries and six fatalities.
9

10 Through their enforcement activities and other participation, the Outagamie County
11 Sheriff's Office, Wisconsin State Patrol, and Outagamie County Highway Department
12 are committed to working together in 2018 to make Work Zone Awareness Week a
13 success. The Federal Highway Administration has designated April 9 through April 13,
14 2018 as "National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week." This resolution will kick off the
15 week and help the campaign to raise awareness for the public safety workers, traveling
16 public, and various highway contractors performing work for counties.

18 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Highway, Recycling and Solid Waste
19 Committee recommend adoption of the following resolution.

20 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors has designated April 9
21 through April 13, 2018 as "Work Zone Safety Awareness Week" in Outagamie County, and

22 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy
23 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Highway Commissioner, the Outagamie County Sheriff and
24 the Outagamie County Executive.
