

Do you have a sick employee? Follow the actions below:

Has symptoms of:	Management Action	Return to Work Criteria for Employee
Vomiting	Exclude from food establishment	Symptom free for at least 48 hours or provide medical documentation that states the symptom is from a noninfectious condition
Diarrhea	Exclude from food establishment	Symptom free for at least 48 hours or provide medical documentation that states the symptom is from a noninfectious condition
Jaundice	Exclude from food establishment	Provide medical documentation to the Health Department that states the food employee is free of the Hepatitis A virus
Sore Throat with Fever	With approval from Health Department restrict from food area of establishment	Provide medical documentation to the Health Department that states employee does not have strep throat
Infected Cut or Wounds	Restrict from any food handling	Apply double barrier (finger cot and glove) when on hand and when on arm, use a single barrier (impermeable bandage)

Hepatitis A virus 3. <i>Shigella</i> spp. 4. <i>E. coli</i> 0157:H7 or other EHEC/STEC infection 5. <i>Salmonella</i> Typhi 	<p>Educate food employee to watch for symptoms or report when feeling ill</p> <p>Ensure employee has good handwashing</p> <p>Verify employee has no bare hand contact with ready-to-eat foods</p> <p>Employee exposure is defined as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exposure to or suspicion of causing any confirmed disease outbreak of the big 5 organisms • A household member diagnosed with the big 5 organisms • A household member attending or working in a setting experiencing a confirmed disease outbreak of the big 5 organisms
