

RESOLUTION NO.: 23—2019-20

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

2/3 MAJORITY – 24 VOTES

1 The Office of Preparedness and Emergency Health Care, Wisconsin Department of
2 Health Services, Division of Public Health, has awarded funding for emergency
3 dispatcher cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training. Funds may be spent to
4 provide CPR training, certification and continuing education. The Sheriff's Office has
5 been awarded \$5,964 to send seven telecommunicators for Emergency Medical Dispatch
6 (EMD) training. The certifications (\$2,555) are through the International Academy of
7 Emergency Dispatch (AED). The training is a three day intensive course covering use
8 of medical protocols which focus on life safety questions and pre-arrival instructions up
9 to and including CPR direction. The straight time salary cost (\$3,409) of sending the
10 telecommunicator to the training is reimbursable. The fringe benefits tied to these
11 wages will be covered in the 2019 adopted budget. There is no county match required.

13 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Public Safety Committee recommend
14 adoption of the following resolution.

15 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does authorize and
16 approve the Outagamie County Sheriff's Office to accept and expend the \$5,964 funding received from
17 the Office of Preparedness and Emergency Health Care, Wisconsin Department of Health Services,
18 Division of Public Health, which will be used for Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) training and
19 salary, and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does approve
21 of increasing the following Law Enforcement Communications cost centers: Intergovernmental
22 Revenue by \$5,964, Salaries by \$3,409 and Travel/Training by \$2,555 as detailed in the attached fiscal
23 note, which by reference is made a part hereof, and

24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy
25 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Finance Director, the Outagamie County Sheriff, and the
26 Outagamie County Executive.
