Purpose of the Meeting

Welcome to the pre-construction information meeting for the proposed pavement repairs on County KK / Calumet St / John St. The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information regarding the project construction schedule and traffic impacts.

Project Location

The roadway concrete repair limits are on County KK / Calumet Street between Telulah Avenue and Kensington Drive and on John Street between Matthias Street and Calumet Street. The project also includes construction of an eastbound right turn lane to the WIS 441 southbound on-ramp.

Project Purpose

The purpose of the project is to improve the roadway driving surface on County KK, Calumet St and John St. This will be accomplished by spot pavement and curb repairs along the corridor. The anticipated location of pavement repairs are illustrated on the project displays.

Project Timeline and Schedule

All work will take place outside of the school year. Construction is scheduled to begin on June 17th and work is anticipated to be completed by August 16th.

Proposed Traffic Control During Construction

During construction, traffic on County KK / Calumet Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction. During approximately the first 3 weeks of construction, traffic will be shifted to the outside lanes (Stage 1 on the project displays). During approximately weeks 4, 5 and 6 of construction, traffic will be moved to the inside lanes (Stage 2 on the project displays). During this time, John Street will be closed to thru traffic between Matthias Street and Calumet Street. Near the end of the Stage 2 work traffic will then be shifted back to the outside lanes (Stage 1 on the project displays) to complete repairs. Construction of the eastbound right turn lane to the WIS 441 southbound ramp will take place during the final 3 weeks of construction.

In order to complete work on westbound Calumet Street between Lake Park Road and Kensington Drive, westbound traffic through the WIS 441 interchange will need to be reduced to one lane, including reducing the dual left turn lanes on the WIS 441 northbound off-ramp and the dual right turn lane on the WIS 441 southbound off-ramp to one lane. This work will take place during off-peak traffic hours of 7 PM in the evening through noon the following day during the week or 4 PM on Saturday through noon on Monday.

In order to complete work within the intersections of Lake Park Drive and Kensington Drive, the intersections will need to be closed to left turns and cross traffic. This work will take place between 7:30 PM and 6 AM Sunday through Thursday evening or between 7:30 PM and 8 AM on Friday and Saturday evenings. When one intersection is restricted, the adjacent intersection will remain open. Each intersection will be

restricted two or three times during the project. Detour signing will be in place during the time each intersection is restricted.

During the project additional intersections west of Lake Park Road may be restricted to not allow left turns or cross traffic for up to 3 days. When intersections are restricted to complete work, access will be maintained at adjacent intersections.

There will be some temporary impacts to business and residential driveway access during construction. The contractor will coordinate all access impacts with property owners in advance of construction activities.

Garbage and recycling pickup

Garbage and recycling containers normally placed along Calumet Street will continue to be picked up when the traffic is on the outside lanes of the roadway at the start of the project. Once traffic is switched to the inside lanes and the outside lanes of Calumet Street are closed, containers must be moved to the nearest side street for pickup.
