TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

2 The Wisconsin Department of Administration and State Prosecutors Office have
3 completed a comprehensive review and offered recommendations to Wisconsin Governor
4 Tony Evers' 2019-21 Biennial Budget veto message related to the allocation of additional
5 Assistant District Attorney (ADA) positions. Governor Evers has announced that
6 Outagamie County will receive funding for two (2) additional ADA positions for a total
7 of eleven (11) full-time state-funded positions in the 2019-21 Biennial Budget.

9 The Legislative/Audit and Human Resources Committee would like to recommend that
10 the Outagamie County Executive retain all current county-funded Special Prosecutor
11 (formerly Law Clerk) positions on the Table of Organization for the Outagamie County
12 District Attorney's Office in addition to the state-funded positions. Retaining the current
13 county-funded Special Prosecutor positions will be beneficial in decreasing the backlog
14 in the District Attorney's Office, continuing to focus on protecting children and families,
15 assist in expanding diversion programs, and improving the response to people in the
16 criminal justice system who suffer from mental illness and substance abuse.

18 The additional ADA positions will require one (1) additional Legal Assistant II position
19 in order to handle the day-to-day activities of the ADA positions.

21 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Legislative/Audit and Human Resources
22 Committee recommend adoption of the following resolution.

23 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does request that the
24 Outagamie County Executive retain all current county-funded Special Prosecutor (formerly Law Clerk)
25 positions on the Table of Organization for the Outagamie County District Attorney's Office in addition
26 to the state-funded positions, and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does request
28 that the Outagamie County Executive include one (1) additional Legal Assistant II position on the Table
29 of Organization of the Outagamie County District Attorney's Office, and
